Precinct Official Appointment Meeting Minutes
August 20, 2019
5 P.M.

Call to Order

- The meeting was called to order by Chairwoman Kelly Shore.

Roll Call

- Present were Chairwoman Kelly Shore, Secretary Paige Wood, Member Marvin Arrington, Member Kevin Lewis and Director John Kearney.

Approval of Minutes from the July 15, 2019 Regular Meeting

- Secretary Paige Wood presented the minutes for approval. Motion was made by Member Marvin Arrington to approve the minutes as submitted. Motion was seconded by Member Kevin Lewis, motion approved unanimously.

Director's Report

- Discussed the upcoming election related meeting dates with the board.
- Informed the board that the Precinct Official Luncheon had been canceled but there would be a dinner for the Chief Judges on the 26th at 6PM.
- Told the board he expected the new board member to be appointed at the State Board meeting on Friday of this week.

Old Business

- Rocky Mount Early Voting Plan – Member Kevin Lewis suggested that the board revisit the Early Voting Plan for the City of Rocky Mount. He suggested that the board consider having the same hours as Edgecombe County and if the board could agree it would avoid the State Board from making the decision.

After some discussion, a motion was made by Member Marin Arrington to unanimously open both sites from 8 AM until 6PM Monday thru Friday and Saturday, September 28th from 10 AM until 2 PM. Motion was seconded by Member Kevin Lewis, motion passed unanimously. This new unanimous plan will be submitted the State Board for approval.

- November Early Voting Plan – Director Kearney stated to the board that early voting for November was usually held in the office for just business hours only. He also stated that no early voting plan was required as this was the minimum required by law. After some discussion the board decided to add one Saturday.
- A motion was made by Member Kevin Lewis to have the office open normal business hours and open Saturday, October 26th from 10 AM until 2 PM. Motion was seconded by Member Marvin Arrington, motion approved unanimously. The unanimous plan will be submitted to the State Board for approval.

New Business

- 2019-21 Precinct Official Appointments – Director Kearney presented the recommended list from the Party Chairs to the board. The board was advised that staff made a recommended list and submitted it to both Party Chairs. Both Party Chairs in turn submitted the recommended list to the board for appointment.

Motion was made by Member Kevin Lewis to appoint the recommended list of Precinct Officials for 2019-21. Motion was seconded by Member Marvin Arrington, motion was approved unanimously. Appointed list is attached to the minutes.
