

Recessed Meeting May 8, 2023
(Joint Meeting with Nash County Public Schools Board of Education)

A recessed meeting of the Nash County Board of Commissioners and a joint meeting with Nash County Public Schools Board of Education was held at 6:00 PM, May 8, 2023 at the Nash County Agriculture Center (1006 Eastern Avenue, Nashville, NC).

Present were Chairman Robbie B. Davis and Commissioners Marvin C. Arrington, Fred Belfield, Jr., Dan Cone, Sue Leggett, J. Wayne Outlaw, and Gwen Wilkins.

Others present were Stacie Shatzer, Scott Rogers, Donna Wood, Dr. Lew Hunnicutt, Adrienne Covington, Katherine Fisher, Paul Jaber, William Marshburn, Nash County Public Schools Board of Education and staff, Janice Evans, Vince Durham, and other staff members and members of the public.

Chairman Davis called the recessed meeting to order and provided a brief explanation regarding prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance in Nash County.
